To the Parents and Guardians of Yuba City Charter School,

First, let me thank you for your patience and support through these trying times. The safety and education of your children is the number one priority of YCCS. That said, the YCCS waiver to resume in-person instruction for grades K-6 has been accepted and approved by both the local health official and the California Department of Public Health (CDPH).

Therefore, as you may have been informed by your child's teacher, we will resume in-person instruction for grades K-6 on Monday, October 19<sup>th</sup>. There are a few differences between how school will open under the waiver verses resuming the normal full-day schedule. Differences are as follows:

- The gates will open at 8:00 am for K-6 instruction ONLY.
- No visitors or guests will be allowed during student instruction hours
- Students will attend school from 8:00 am to 12:35 pm
- All students must be picked up on time at 12:35
- All safety precautions must be observed at all times
- Students with a temp of 100.4 or higher will be turned away at the gate.
- Material pick-up and drop-off will be from 12:45 until 3:00 Monday through Thursday and 12:45 until 2:00 on Fridays
- Students may pick up their lunches at the YCUSD site where they have been picking them up prior to this reopening until further notice.
- Arrangements will be made with teachers to accommodate distance learning for any student or family who is sick, at risk, or unwilling to attend school in person. These accommodations may vary from teacher to teacher.

High school students, grades 7-12 have not been cleared to return yet. To better serve our community, a Zoom meeting has been scheduled for parent input into the reopening of the high school. That meeting will be on Thursday, October 22<sup>nd</sup>, at 5:30. The link to the meeting will be posted on the web page prior to the meeting date. Please plan to attend to help advise the decision making process.
