Cell Phone & Electronic Device Policy

1. Cell phones will be allowed on campus.
2. Cell phones, MUST NOT be visible, or powered up during class time. If a cell phone is heard or seen by a teacher or aide, under any circumstances, during class time, the phone will be confiscated.
3. Ear buds or headsets may not be used in class at any time. If Ear buds or headsets of any kind are visible in class, they will be confiscated.
4. I-pods or other electronic devices are not to be used during any class time. If such devices are visible or detected in class, they will be confiscated.
5. Cell phones may only be used outside of class.
6. Calling parents or answering calls from parents is not acceptable during class and is not allowed. Parents, needing to contact students during class time must call the front office.
7. Students who refuse to hand over a cell phone requested by a teacher or other authorized school employee will be suspended for defiance.
8. The following procedure will be used to handle confiscated electronic devices:
  - a. First offense: Student may retrieve the device from the office after school
  - b. Second offense: Student's parent or guardian MUST retrieve the device for the student.
  - c. Third offense: Student will no longer be allowed to possess an electronic device at school.
  - d. Fourth offense: Student will be suspended for one day each time he or she is found to be in possession of an electronic device for the remainder of the school year.
9. Students bringing electronic devices to school are solely responsible for the device. YCCS assumes no liability for lost, stolen or damaged electronic devices.
10. Cell phones may be used in class by teachers only to conduct school business or in the event of an emergency or communications system failure.

By signing this document, we understand and agree that YCCS is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged cell phones or any other electronic device under any circumstance. Cell Phones and electronic devices are brought to school solely at the risk of the parent and student.
